OPERATION CYBER IDAHO

In partnership with the Idaho Army National Guard and Department of Defense, ITS executed **20** cyber training events, training **124** participants over **1,525** days with an estimated community benefit to Idaho of **\$2.7 million**.

APPRENTICESHIP PROGRAM

Collaborative effort launched with Boise State University and ITS designed to strengthen Idaho's cybersecurity posture by connecting university students and local statewide partners.

The program places skilled apprentices in counties, cities, school districts and other entities providing hands-on experience and preparedness.
